

Rules

1. Disclaimer of liability *****

Save the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organiser or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability whatsoever while upon the show ground or while entering or leaving the same, for any death, injury or loss or damage to any competitor or to his agent or her agent or to any animals, plant, machinery or thing brought into show ground or while entering or leaving or being carried in or out of the said show ground. Each competitor shall be responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may be done or occasioned by, or arising from any animal, article or property, exhibited or brought to into the show ground and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Town Place Equestrian Centre from all and against all actions, suits expenses and claims on account or in respect of any such damage or injury which may be caused or occasioned.

2. Health and Safety

Town Place Equestrian Centre, the organiser of the event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

3. The organisers reserve the right to cancel, add to or amend any class as they see fit, and to refuse entry with out stating a reason.

4. In the unfortunate event of cancellation of the show £2.00 per entry will be retained.

5. Shows will be run under the governing bodies rules ie BSJA, BD, BE, Pony Club etc.

6. The decision of the judge is final. Objection must be lodged with the secretary within 30 mins of the event accompanied by a deposit of £10, forfeited if overruled.

7. **Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.**

8. The fields are permanent pasture. Please do not muck out on to the fields. Please take all litter home with you.

9. No horse under the age of 4 years may enter a ridden class.

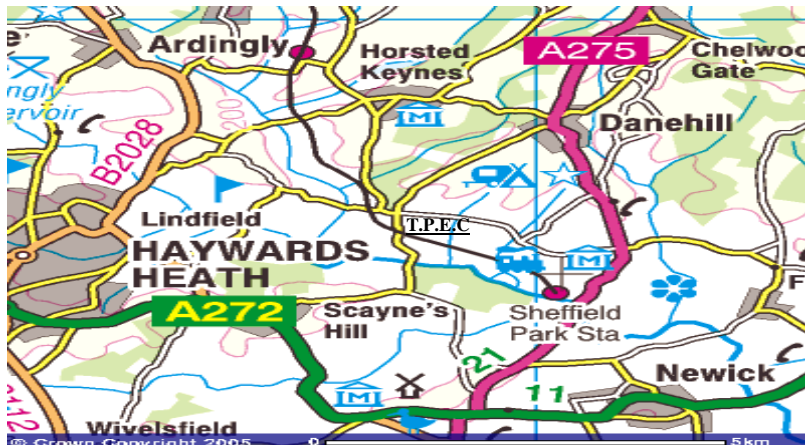
10. No entry will be accepted without the correct remittance or refunded unless a veterinary or medical certificate is produced. Cheque's to be accompanied by cheque card number.

- 4 B E Track left half circle left twenty metres diameter
- 5 A Medium walk
- 6 B X E Half circle left ten metres diameter to X
Half circle right ten metres diameter to E
E Working trot
- 7 H C M working trot
M X K Change rein in working trot
- 8 A Serpentine three loops, each loop to go to side of arena finishing at
C
- 9 C Medium walk
- 10 H X F Change the rein at a free walk on a long rein
F Medium walk
- 11 A Down centre line
D Working trot
G Halt, Immobility, Salute.

COLLECTIVE MARKS

- 12 Paces (freedom and regularity)
- 13 Impulsion (desire to move forward, elasticity of steps and suppleness of the back)

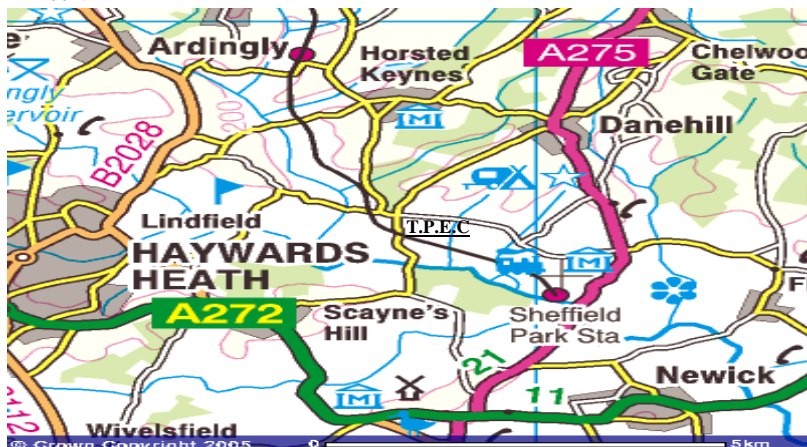

- 7 H C M working trot
M X K Change rein in working trot
- 8 A Serpentine three loops, each loop to go to side of arena finishing at C
9 C Medium walk
- 10 H X F Change the rein at a free walk on a long rein
F Medium walk
- 11 A Down centre line
D Working trot
G Halt, Immobility, Salute.
